

Chromebook Borrower Announcement

Brighton Area Schools will be conducting our chromebook borrowing tomorrow, the details for which are included below:

- **What:** Chromebook loan event
- **Who:** Families that completed the BAS COVID-19 Technology Access Spring 2020 [survey](#) that was part of a Curriculum & Technology March 19, 2020 update, pushed to Facebook and Twitter, as well as posted on our BrightonK12.com homepage. Important: **A parent or legal guardian must be present to borrow a chromebook.**
- **Where:** BECC parking lot (125 South Church Street, adjacent to Sloan Field)
- **When:** Wednesday, April 8, 2020, from 2 to 4 P.M.
- **How:** In order to better manage chromebook retrieval, signing the chromebook borrower agreement, and to mitigate potential parking lot congestion, we are requesting families adhere to the following schedule:
 - Last name begins with the letter A - F: 2:00 - 2:30 P.M.
 - Last name G - K: 2:30 - 3:00 P.M.
 - Last name L - P: 3:00 - 3:30 P.M.
 - Last name Q - Z: 3:30 - 4:00 P.M.
 - All others unable to attend the above timeslots: 4:00 - 5:00 P.M.

These loaner chromebooks are being prioritized for families that do not currently have technology at home, or families with more than two students and only a single device. Some final important information:

- Chromebooks borrowed from Brighton Area Schools will be disinfected before presented to you, and we will make every effort to conduct safe exchanges of devices and paperwork. You are encouraged to bring your own pen.
- If you currently possess a family tablet, laptop or desktop computer, or a chromebook for use with your student(s), then you already have access to the BAS online learning that will commence during the week of April 13.
- While microphones allow for speech interactivity, it is not necessary for you to have a webcam to participate in BAS online learning opportunities.
