Dear Parents and Guardians,

The staff of Brighton High School has made final arrangements for our **new online Back-to-School registration** which begins August 5, 2019. Please review the materials carefully in preparation for your child's registration. This carefully prepared newsletter is designed to inform and assist you. With our new required online process your student's registration must be completed **BEFORE** their registration day.

If you do not have access to a computer or have questions regarding the new online registration, we have set up times in the Main Office to assist you. We will have Chrome Books and personnel available from 8am - 2pm August 12th through August 14th. Also, on August 12th we will be available in the evening from 5pm - 7pm.

Scheduling corrections will be held during registration week. The dates are listed below. Please note: Only changes regarding failures or incomplete schedules will be honored at this time in the Counseling Office.

2019/2020 BHS Back-To-School Registrations Procedures

Registration Dates:

Band Students ONLY - Friday, August 16 8a - 11a

Seniors	Mon., Aug. 19	7am - 11am
Juniors	Mon., Aug. 19	12am - 4pm
Sophomores	Tues., Aug. 20	7am - 11pm
Freshmen	Tues., Aug. 20	12am - 4pm

There will be no make-up day so please come on your scheduled day and time.

On Your Registration Day

All registration activities will take place in the cafeteria at the high school. When you arrive at registration, ***please make sure all forms are fully completed.*** All necessary forms can be found online. Incomplete forms slow the entire registration process down. Be prepared to be photographed (including seniors).

Absolutely no one may register prior to your scheduled time on registration day!

Following is a basic walk through on what you will accomplish during registration and the fees needed.

Check In

All students will stop at check in for verification of On-line Registration completion and Past book fines if applicable. Past Book Fines - Past book fines must be paid in full before the student will be allowed to obtain parking, receive their schedule, locker, etc.

Cashier

Book fines, student agendas and parking are paid. We accept checks (made out to Brighton High School), cash, credit/debit cards or you may pay for items online through Parent Connect. Visit <https://sisweb.resa.net/ParentPortal/> to pay online.

Athletics

Fall sports tryout information and sports pass information can be found at godogs.org. Tryout information will also be available from the High School Main Office and outside the Athletic Office.

BHS Food Service

Lunch money deposits will be collected for the computerized lunch program at BHS. Food Service representatives will be available to discuss the computerized lunch program. Check payable to BHS Food Service.

Brighton Area Schools offers a program for free or reduced lunches. Information can be found in the online Back-to-School Registration.

BHS PARKING PERMIT

The cost of parking permits for the 2019/2020 school year is \$60. This fee must be paid at registration in order to secure a parking spot. Parking applications are online or in the main office. Students must have a valid driver's license; a driving permit will not be accepted. Both students and parents must read the rules for parking at BHS.

School Pictures

All students must be photographed. Lifetouch photographers will be here to photograph all students for the required yearbook photo and BHS ID cards. The ID cards are free for all students. Students should come properly clothed and adorned for pictures. All students have the option of purchasing picture packages. Check payable to Lifetouch National School Studios or you may go to their "website" to purchase packages online.

Locker Assignments

All students will have a locker assigned to them. Locker assignments and locker combinations can be found on the student's schedule.

Class Schedules

Student class schedules will be distributed during registration.

Close Up Government 2019/2020

Close Up Government is a class for students who are interested in combining their required course in American Government with a weeklong workshop in Washington D.C. Close Up students will meet with students from across the country as they learn about the responsibilities of citizenship and view our government using a hands on approach. Cost of the program is approximately \$1,850. All students electing to take Close Up Government are required to make the trip to D.C.

Parents are reminded that a ***\$400 non-refundable*** deposit is due at registration in August, if payment was not made prior to registration day.

If your son/daughter can not attend the August registration, please contact me. ***Any student not making a deposit at registration must make a schedule change.*** Contact your counselor prior to the start of fall classes.

If your son/daughter is interested in Close Up Government and has not registered for the class, contact your counselor for information, as some space is still available. If you have any questions regarding this class please feel free to contact me.

BHS PTO donation, Information & Volunteer Form

The PTO will be collecting BHS PTO Donations and your Information & Volunteer Forms at registration. Student directory deletions are due at registration or turned in at the main office by Friday, September 27, 2019. The BHS PTO will also be collecting the annual suggested donation of \$25. If you are not making a donation on-line but still want to make a donation, they will accept cash or check Payable to **BHS PTO**.

Brighton Alumni Scholarship

A representative will be available to talk about the Brighton Alumni Association. The Brighton Alumni Association awards scholarships each year. All donations go directly to the students. (suggested donation amount is \$10, however any amount would be appreciated.) If you are not making a donation on-line but still want to make a donation, they will accept cash or check Payable to the **Brighton Alumni Association**.

Optional Student Insurance

Parents can elect to carry a policy through the school that will cover a student during the school day or one that will cover a student for a 24-hour period. Student Insurance can be found in the Back to School online registration.

2020 BHS Senior All Night Party

The 2020 Senior All Night Party will be selling tickets at \$50 and collecting donations for the big event to be held Graduation Night. You do not have to be a parent of a senior to donate. This party is an annual community gift to the graduating class of Brighton High School. The party allows our young people to party in a safe, drug and alcohol free environment. Please see the Senior All Night Party Volunteer form in the Back to School registration or on the BHS Web-site. At this time payment cannot be made online. We will accept cash or check payable to **BHS Senior All Nigh Party**.

Student Daily Agenda - *Student daily agendas will be on sale during registration for \$5*

Trying to be more organized this year? Wanting to stay on top of assignment due dates, important ideas and school events? Purchasing an agenda can be a tremendous help. Agendas are a terrific way to plan your day and keep track of your responsibilities. Our student planners have plenty of space to write assignment information. Upcoming social and school events can be charted through using the monthly calendar overview. A section of the agenda is devoted to the student handbook. It has everything students need to know about BHS expectations.

The staff encourages all students to purchase an agenda for \$5 at registration.

Registration Payment

We are requiring the on-line payment for your registration items. This offers you the opportunity to pay your student's registration fees and fines over the internet using **Parent Connect**. Instructions to pay online can be found at

Address Information

If you have moved and your address has changed from the beginning of the last school year, **YOU ARE REQUIRED** to provide proof of residency. This will even affect those families that have moved but are still Brighton Area School Residence. Proof of residency can be in the form of a closing statement, current utility bill, (ie: Consumers Power, Detroit Edison), copy of your lease or mortgage, tax bill. We will be verifying all addresses for all students at registration. Please come prepared with the necessary documents to avoid any type of delay in registration.
