



BACK TO SCHOOL REGISTRATION

August 2020

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The staff of The Bridge has made final arrangements for our **online, Back To School Registration** which begins 8/12/2020. Please review the materials carefully in preparation for your student's registration. This newsletter is designed to inform and assist you with our **required online process**. Your student's online registration must be completed **BEFORE** their in-person registration day. **Please note:** You **must** follow the allotted day listed alphabetically to allow for social distancing, and **masks are required to enter the building**.

If you do not have access to a computer or have questions regarding the online registration, we will have a computer set up in the main hallway for your use.

Registration Dates: Last Names A-K Monday, August 31, 2020, 9:00am-3:00pm

Last Names L-Z Tuesday, September 1, 2020, 9:00am-3:00pm

On your Registration Day Masks are Required! When you arrive at registration, ***please make sure all forms are fully completed.*** You will be required to fill out a COVID survey upon entering the building. All necessary forms can be found online. Incomplete forms slow the entire registration process down. Photographs for student ID will be taken at a later date.

Check in at the Office: All students must have completed the mandatory **online, Back To School registration**. If this is completed, the student will receive his/her schedule.

Student Emergency Cards: We will have a printed Student Emergency Card for you to check and sign at Registration.

BAS Food Service: Lunch money deposits can be made through Parent Connect. Brighton Area Schools offers a program for free or reduced lunches. Information can be found in the **online Back-to-School Registration**. Free and reduced lunch forms will be collected during the student's in person registration.

Locker Assignments: Lockers are not mandatory for students. The student can request a locker at any time during the school year if desired. Backpacks are not allowed.

Student Parking: There is no fee for student parking in our lot. Students are required to fill out a Student Vehicle Information form, which will be available in the office at registration, or on our website under "Re-Registration Additional Forms."

Address Information: If you have moved and your address has changed from the beginning of the last school year, YOU ARE REQUIRED to provide proof of residency. This will even affect those families that have moved but are still Brighton Area School Residents. Proof of residency can be in the form of a closing statement, current utility bill, (ie: Consumers Power, Detroit Edison), copy of your lease or mortgage or property tax bill. We will be verifying all addresses for all students at registration. Please come prepared with the necessary documents to avoid delay at registration. Athletics: Bridge students are eligible to participate in athletics at Brighton High School. The most current sports tryout information can be found at godogs.org.

The first day of school will be Tuesday, September 8th, and the 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th will be half days with dismissal at 11:15am. Each week after that, school will be in session in the building on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays students will work online from home, and will be our enrichment days. More information about this will be shared with you in the coming weeks.
