

Return to Learn Topic	Strategy
Physical distancing	Spacing strategies will be used to allow for the recommended 3 feet of physical distancing wherever possible.
Facial coverings	The Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) recommends the use of facemasks when indoors. While not a mandate, we encourage families to review this recommendation when making decisions regarding mask usage. <a href="#">LCHD</a>
Staying home when sick/getting tested	Students or staff with symptoms of infectious illness such as Covid-19 should stay home. Should an individual test positive for COVID-19, they will follow the LCHD guidelines for isolation. <a href="#">Link</a>
Close Contact	<b>Unlike the end of last year, the LCHD will be identifying any students within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more as close contacts.</b>
Quarantine	<p>If an unvaccinated student or staff member is identified as a close contact, the following options will be presented to this individual by the LCHD:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) <u>Standard Quarantine</u> – Quarantine for 10 days at home.</li> <li>2) <u>LCHD Alternative to Quarantine Option</u> – <a href="https://www.livgov.com/health/ph/Pages/COVID-19-Alternate-Quarantine-Overview.aspx">https://www.livgov.com/health/ph/Pages/COVID-19-Alternate-Quarantine-Overview.aspx</a></li> </ol> <p><i>*Fully vaccinated individuals will not be subject to quarantine.</i></p>
Cleaning and disinfection	Standard cleaning protocols will be in place using products approved by the CDC to be effective against the COVID-19 virus.
Ventilation	Ventilation systems in buildings will continue to operate to design specifications. On school buses, windows may be opened slightly when safe and practicable.
Daily screeners	It remains the responsibility of families to conduct a daily self-screener. If the answer is “no” to all questions, no additional action is needed. If the answer is “yes”, you will keep your child home and notify the school. There is no daily Google Form to submit. <a href="#">Daily Self-Screener</a>
Transportation	The CDC travel order was not lifted as expected, <b>thus masks will continue to be mandatory for all passengers on school buses until such time as this mandate is lifted</b> <a href="#">CDC Transportation Mandate</a>
Grouping Strategies	At the elementary level, the use of cohort bubbles/pods will continue where appropriate and practicable.

Food service	Additional spacing will be used at the secondary level and elementary students will continue to eat lunch with their classes.
Athletics and extra-curricular activities	No additional rules apply for extra-curricular activities beyond the protocols used during the school day.
