IV. Shining Stars

- A. Curriculum/Instruction
 - NCA Update Dr. Surrey reviewed the NCA Accreditation report from the site visit of May 3-5, 2010. On behalf of the Board of Education President Leach thanked everyone for their preparation and work completed for the NCA visit and process.

2. Social Studies Textbooks - Last year the board approved funds for the purchase of social studies textbooks.

- 3. Curriculum Crafters Curriculum Crafters was developed by Kent County ISD and contains a variety of information on the core curriculum content areas. The feedback from Brighton's teachers is that this would be a very useful tool to have available. The purchase price is \$14,566 and would be supported by AARA money which LESA agreed to provide. However, there is an annual maintenance fee of \$2,185 which the district would be responsible for. Dr. Surrey will share a power point presentation on this program at the May 24, 2010 Board meeting.
- B. Finance
 - Dr. Gistinger reviewed the progress to date on the Deficit Elimination Plan. The district is nearing the end of implementing items that are not negotiable under the Collective Bargaining Agreements.
- C. Human Resources
 - Mr. Schwager reported that representatives were on site to interview Brighton employees for custodial positions available through D.M. Burr.
- D. Other
 - 1. Dr. Gray reported that he will conduct the final Community Forum for the school year on May 20, 2010 at 7 PM in the BCPA. Items to be discussed will be an update on the Deficit Elimination Plan, NCA Visit findings, staffing, strategic planning and time will be provided for audience questions.
