2. Anne Rennie be laid off from his administrative position effective June 30, 2013; and that the administrative contract of employment of Anne Rennie be non-renewed for financial reasons.
3. Susan Johnson be laid off from his administrative position effective June 30, 2013; and that the administrative contract of employment of Susan Johnson be non-renewed for financial reasons.
4. The Superintendent, or his designee, is directed to provide these administrators with written notice of this action.
5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby rescinded.
