1. 5th Grade Reproductive Health Clarification

Scott Brenner, Maltby Intermediate School principal, shared concerns from his 5th grade staff regarding the new reproductive health videos that were approved. The staff appreciated the content, presentation and updated information provided in the new videos. However, there is no mention or explanation of sexual intercourse. The staff and Mr. Brenner asked the committee to approve their continued use of the older video, specifically the segment that does explain/define sexual intercourse. The committee unanimously approved their request.

2. NHS Mental Health Survey- Miriam DeWolf, BHS Student

Miriam was unable to attend, but shared prior to the meeting that the NHS sent out the Mental Health Survey, but there were not enough respondents to make any determinations or recommendations. It is understood that next year's NHS will try to conduct the survey again, and to a wider audience.

3. Stop the Bleed

a. House Bill No. 4334

Concern was shared as HB4334 would require all staff to be trained in "Stop the Bleed". Committee agrees the rationale is appropriate, however, not all teachers and school employees comfortable dealing with blood. It is our goal to seek volunteers in each building for first phase of training. Similar to Cardiac Response Team protocols.
