Front Page Newspaper Layout & Design using InDesign

Document setup: $18 \times 25 = (18 \times 3 \text{ banner}) + (18 \times 22 \text{ paper})$

Gutters – default (0.1667)

Margins –0.125 Columns – 5

Required items:

Each design principle and design element

In the banner name of paper, Date, Volume Issue and many more to fill it up

Autobiography / biography story about yourself (past, present, future, real, fake)

Image of self to go with bio

At least 4 other articles (can be part of an article)

Text wrap (image around text)

Link your columns (text continues into next text area)

Justified text – at least 1 article

Shading in a shape (light gray) behind text box (text box slightly smaller)

Lines & borders: to break up your articles

Other options to include: weather, table of contents, highlights

Banner = the top of the paper : Create in Illustrator -18×3

----not just the title of the newspaper ---look at examples

Consider shading areas, images and articles over more than one column, lines, borders to improve the look of your newspaper







Text Wrapping

- 1. Draw **frame tool** and **place** image
- 2. Open Text Wrap palette
- 3. Choose to wrap around object shape




With your text wrap palette open and the image selected, you will WRAP your TEXT around the IMAGE.




Link Columns

- 1. When your text box runs out of space for all of your text
- 2. You will see a red x in bottom right corner of text box
- 3. Click on red x and click with your mouse where you would like the text to overflow to on your document



Place text in a different location (see the second column)

Use the Preview button



Shaded background of article

How to Create a shaded background for an article to help it stand out from the other articles

1st- create a shape

2nd - use 10% black


3rd - create a text box

4th put your text for the article in the text box

5th - make sure the shape is behind the text (Object, arrange)


6th - make sure the text box is slightly smaller than the shape. You do NOT want the Edge of the Text to touch the Edge of the Shape

7th - make sure the entire space is filled you don't want shape with color and no text



Justified Text US Align Left

<u>JUSTIFIED</u> is used for **NEWS** LEFT is used for **ENTERTAINMENT**



justified text justified text is text that spans from the left of the column to the right of the column. It is not centered text. It is not left aligned text. It is not right alighned text.

Choose window, then Type & Tables. Next choose Paragraph. This is the Paragraph palette. You will have all the options of different alignment to choose from.
