Document setup: 12 x 18
Gutters – default (0.1667)
Margins – 0.125
Columns – 5

Information to include:

You must use every design principle and design element

In the banner name of paper, Date, Volume Issue and many more
Autobiography story about yourself

Word collage about yourself you - File and Place into a frame

At least 4 other articles

You must use text wrap (image around text)

You must link your columns (text continues into next text area)

You must justify some of your text

You must use shading, lines, borders: to break up your articles

Other options to include: weather, table of contents, highlights

Banner = the top of the paper : Create in Illustrator – 12 x 2.5

-----not just the title of the newspaper ---look at examples

Consider shading areas, images and articles over more than one column, lines, borders to



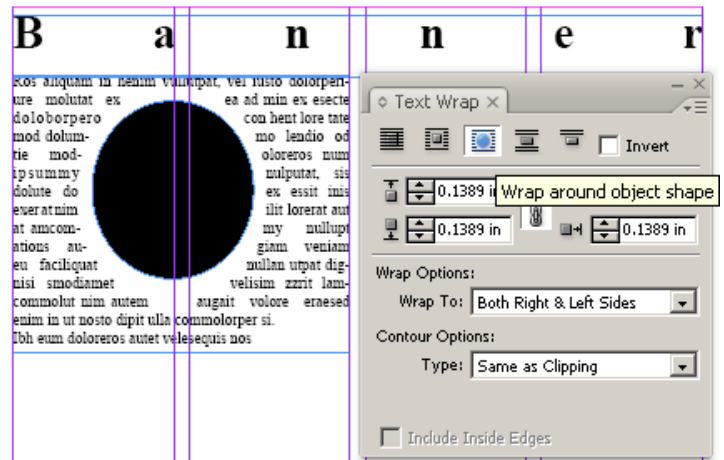
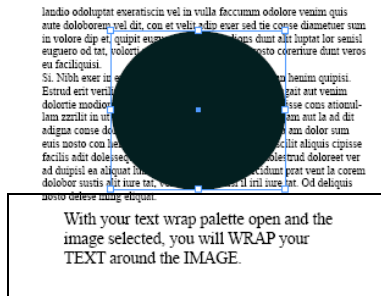

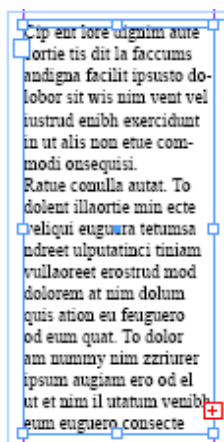
Text Wrapping

1. Draw **frame tool** and **place image**
2. Open **Text Wrap** palette
3. Choose to wrap around object shape

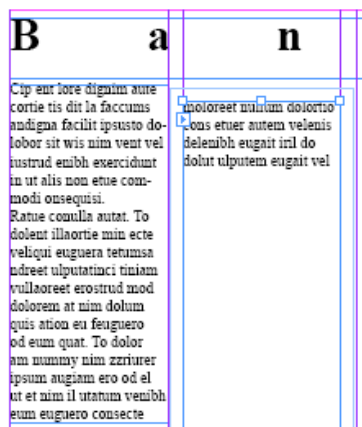


Link Columns

1. When your text box runs out of space for all of your text
2. You will see a red x in bottom right corner of text box
3. Click on red x and click with your mouse where you would like the text to overflow to on your document



Click on red X



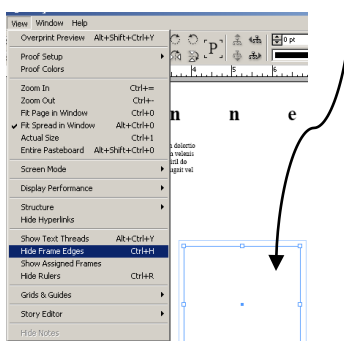
Place text in a different location (see the second column)

Justified Text VS Align Left

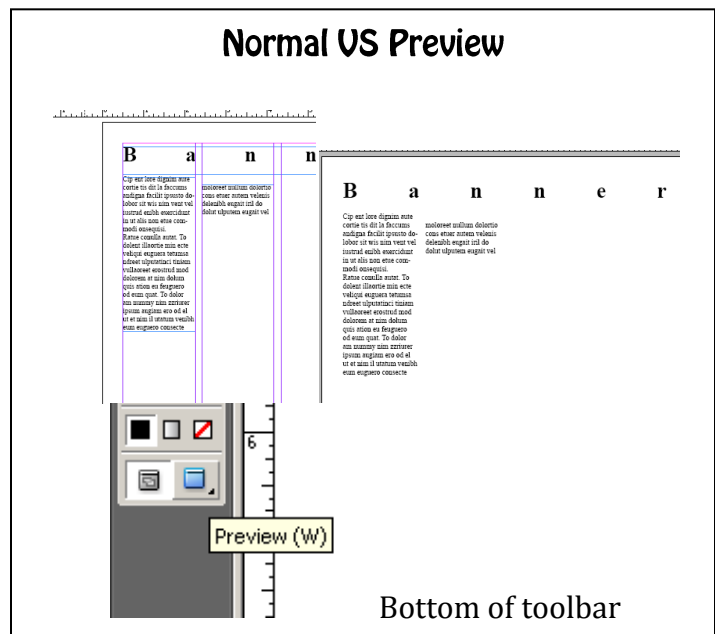
JUSTIFIED is used for **NEWS**
