In order to create your storyline.....Answer these questions FIRST:

1. Who is the main character?
2. Is the character happy, mysterious, curious, afraid, adventurous
3. When does this take place? Past, present, future, day or night....
4. Where does this take place? Land, sea, vehicle, space
5. Why is this written, what is the morale of the story/metaphor/problem solved?
6. How does the problem start and how is the problem solved?

SETUP

Create the: - **graphics and/or whole page in Illustrator** & **Layout in InDesign** and embed files

SIZE = 4.25 width x 5.5 height

12 pages with 0.25 margins

Insert page numbers = Type, insert, special characters

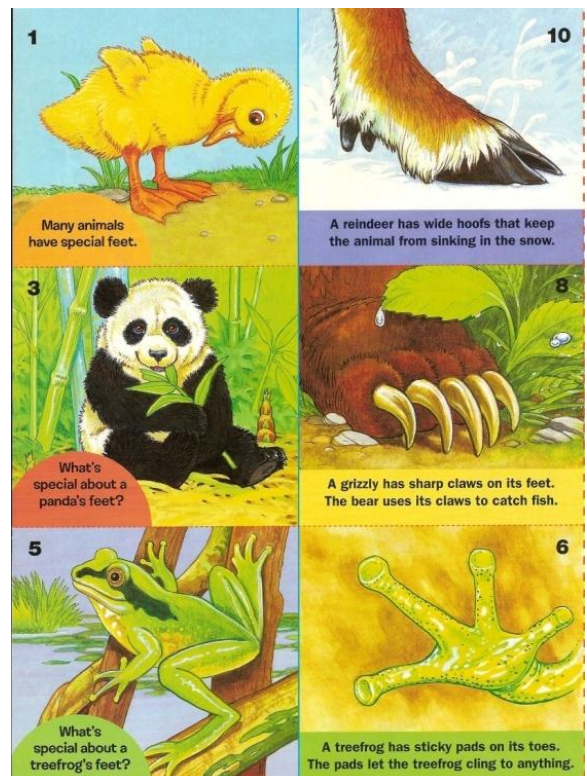
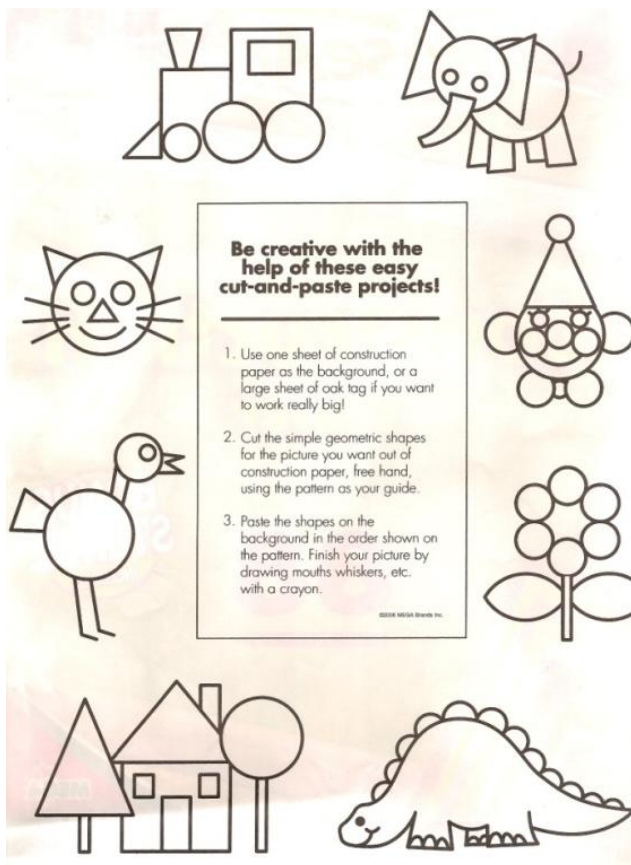
Use the pages palette, master pages to put a border or page numbers on ALL pages at once

Items to Include

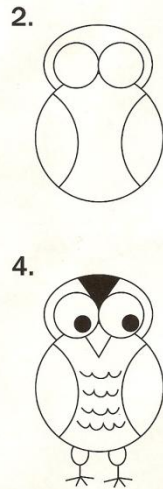
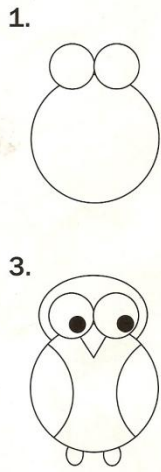
Title	Background developed

Page #'s (book)	Problem /issue obvious start and finish
Character(s) you designed	Include: Most if not all of the above techniques

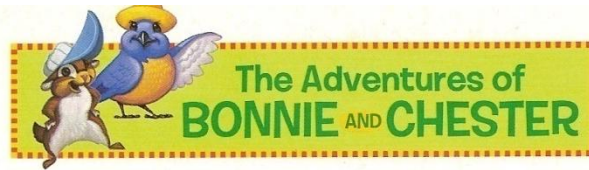

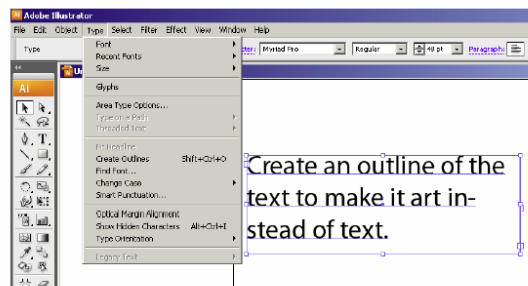
4. Any images or graphics MUST be placed in the document:

For ALL Text in InDesign you MUST create outlines

Create Outlines

To create outlines of text. 1. Create text. 2. Click on the black arrow. 3. Choose Type menu. Create outlines. The text is now converted to art.



This is what your text will look like after it has been converted to outlines. Now each letter/character is its own piece.

Create an outline of the text to make it art instead of text.
